**Establishment of a new Insurance Scheme (Agrahara) for  
Public Officers in terms of the Budgetary Proposals for 2005**

Your attention is drawn to the Public Administration Circular No 12/2005 dated 18.05.2005.

02. The family unit defined in Medical Insurance Scheme under Part I of Annex 01 of above circular is hereby revised in the following manner.

Married Employees :- member, spouse and unemployed and unmarried children under 21 years of age and unmarried, unemployed and totally disabled children even though they are over 21 years of age.

03. For the purpose of reimbursing entitlements under Agrahara Insurance Scheme for Hospital and Medical Fees for children of married Public officers, who are totally disabled unemployed and unmarried even though they are over 21 years of age, the Head of the Institution shall certify most recent diagnosis cards of such children and further it shall be certified that the said child is over 21 years of age and he is unmarried, unemployed and totally disabled. In the meantime a certificate obtained from the relevant Grama Niladhari to the effect that the above particulars relating to the child are true and correct, shall be submitted to National Insurance Trust Fund.
